

Declaration of Conformity, RoHS 3 (EU 2015/863)

The RoHS Directive (EU) 2015/863 also known as the Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive, places defined obligations on manufacturers, importers, and distributors of electrical and electronic equipment. It mandates restrictions on the use of substances listed in Annex II of the Directive, unless exemptions are specified in Annexes III and IV. The following substances are limited to concentrations not exceeding:

Lead	0.1%
Mercury	0.1%
Cadmium	0.01%
Hexavalent chromium	0.1%
Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	0.1%
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	0.1%
Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

Our product catalogue includes speed sensors for ISO/SAE motors. These accessories contain lead in concentrations exceeding 0.1%, but are covered by the regulatory exemption 6c specified in Annex III, which allow for scientific and technical adaptations:

- 6a) Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes and in galvanized steel, up to 0.35% by weight.
- 6b) Lead as an alloying element in aluminum, up to 0.4% by weight.
- 6c) Copper alloys containing up to 4% lead by weight.

Accordingly, all products and components supplied by Sunfab Hydraulics AB comply with the updated Directive (EU) 2015/863 amending the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU.
